Saturday Tajweed Class After Fajr (Led by Shaykh Ismael Essa)

This class will teach you the basics of proper pronunciation when reading the Qur'an

Sunday After Fajr Prayer Tafseer (Led by Dr Esseghir)

Please join us in this weekly Tafseer Program, (now in its 6th year); a reading session from Tafseer Ibn Katheer, an opportunity to dive into a wealth of Qur'anic wisdom from the best and most authentic commentators of the Qur'an. Ibn Katheer's methodology stands out as he explains a Quranic verse by first using other related verses. Afterwards, he uses Hadith and Circumstances of Revelation to strengthen the explanation. Finally, he brings the understanding of the Companions and Tab'eens for further explanation. Scholars of Tafseer acknowledge this was one of the greatest contributions of Imam Ibn Katheer and some refer to his Tafseer as "nothing like it was ever written".

Sunday After Dhuhr Knowledge Class (Led by Dr Heba Elkhateeb)

Every Sunday after Dhuhr an Islamic knowledge class is taught by Dr Heba Elkhateeb. This on-going class aims at teaching Islamic knowledge and fiqh to all levels of Muslims. Non-Muslims are always welcomed. The class has an open format so questions are always welcomed and each one addressed. The class is open to both brothers and sisters.

Sunday After Magrib Prayer Fiqh (Led by Brahim Messai)

Learn the essentials of Deen in this weekly forum which will cover the basics of faith, purification, prayer, fasting, Zakat, and other central topics related to your everyday life as a Muslim. This class will be based on the fiqh book Bulugh al-Maram.
