The Islamic Society of Central Jersey (ISCJ) held its annual Weekend School Graduation ceremonies on Sunday, June 8.

Approximately 400 people attended the event, which included students, teachers, school administrators, ISCJ Board members, ISCJ religious leader, Imam Hamad Chebli, and Assemblyman Jack Ciatterelli, R-16.

The students were recognized and awarded with trophies and certificates for their accomplishments throughout the school year which included academic and character achievements, Quran (Islam's holy book) memorization and reading competition and Islamic knowledge competition.

High school and college graduates were also recognized and awarded a monetary gift.

Approximately 600 students attend the Saturday and Sunday ISCJ Weekend School.

The weekend classes that are held throughout the school year focus on learning to read Arabic, reading and memorization of verses from the Quran and learning Islamic history.
